

## **COVID-19 Technology Action Plan**

### **Belleville Mennonite School**

*In the case of face to face classes being cancelled, the following action plan will be put into place. This Action Plan will be continually updated so the most updated plan will be available at <https://www.bmsprek12.org/academics/technology.cfm>.*

#### **Values**

- Students will continue to receive high quality learning delivered through multiple technologies
- Teachers will have the necessary tools and access to training to technology tools so that they can create high quality learning activities.

#### **Students**

- Students who do not have access to computers at home but do have access to Internet will be provided a school owned Chromebook.
- Students will need to step up to the plate and assume greater responsibility and initiative for their learning.
- Teacher recorded lessons of five to ten minutes will help explain concepts and key ideas in lessons.

#### **Teachers**

- Teachers will be provided with laptops and technology tools that will allow them to work from at home or onsite to deliver video instruction, engaged learning assignments, both synchronous and asynchronous learning opportunities that give feedback to students.
- Daily posting announcements through Google Classroom..
- Daily virtual "Office Hours" provide students with the opportunity to connect with students..
- Teachers will record short lessons of between 5 to 10 minutes.

#### **Available Learning Tools**

- Google **Classroom** is the school-wide Learning Management System. Teachers will be placing their lesson plans and activities on Google Classroom so that students will be able to access worksheets, assignments and general information/announcements.

- **Socrative** and **Kahoot** are available tools that may be used to increase interactive lesson activities.
- For Virtual face to face meetings, a tool like Google's **Meet** can allow for teacher to student conferencing. (Because this is part of the GSuite app, this might be easier to use instead of Zoom. Students just need to log into their school's GSuite account.)
- **Screencast-o-matic** is an online tool that allows teachers and students to record their voice and capture their screen to demonstrate learning and present key ideas.
- Additional learning tools provide student-centric learning.
